

“Linear” Stormwater Permitting

WWE has worked collaboratively with the City and County of Denver, Denver Water and Xcel Energy to develop streamlined SWMPs for linear utility projects with consistent construction activities and associated BMPs that occur in multiple locations throughout the City and County of Denver. “Master” SWMPs have been developed for construction activities including undergrounding of electrical lines, aging gas main replacement and utility relocations along major transportation corridors. “Master” SWMPs provided Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) and BMPs for construction activities and address local and state stormwater requirements. The “Master” SWMP includes “typical” BMPs associated with various construction activities, for example BMPs used for trenching in a paved area.



To provide the site-specific information required by state and local permits, a brief narrative and BMP site map are prepared for each project location and are attached to the “Master” SWMP. The “typical” BMP details from the “Master” SWMP allow for simplified call-outs on the site-specific maps, greatly simplifying BMP site plans, especially for long projects. Site-specific features such as inlets, outlets, slopes, flow direction and others are shown on the customized maps.

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
