

Parkfield Pond

WWE designed a water quality wetland pond at the Rocky Mountain Arsenal (RMA) situated near the Denver International Airport access corridor. The project was created to manage stormwater for developing areas upstream, reduce downstream flooding, create wildlife habitat and enhance stormwater quality. The project features 1,200 linear feet of engineered wetland channel, which discharges into a 5-acre pond. The facility is located on the RMA, a Superfund site, as part of its transition from one of the most polluted areas in the United States to an urban wildlife refuge.

The Parkfield Pond has become a valued resource at the RMA, providing outstanding wetland habitat. The project was realized through the cooperation of several public and private entities including the Department of the Army, the United States Fish and Wildlife Service, the Urban Drainage and Flood Control District, Denver Water, Parkfield Partners, LLC, and WWE.
